SACE to launch the teacher's rights, responsibilities, and safety programme in North West province

The South African Council for Educators (SACE), a statutory body responsible for enhancing the status of the teaching profession, recently launched a programme on Teachers Rights, Responsibilities and Safety in Gauteng. Emanating from the national launch which was held in March 2019, the Council will be embarking on launching the programme in all nine provinces from April - June 2019. This is part of the Council's resolution to address the scourge of violence happening in our schools.

The launch session will take the form of an interactive conference of more than 300 teachers in various districts of the North West province. The MEC of Education – North West, Honourable Sello Lehari will deliver the key-note address at the envisaged launch.

The launch, which is themed: "The rights to education means the rights to safe teaching environment" aims at concertising both teachers and broader society on rights and responsibilities of teachers and most importantly ensuring that teachers are safe at all times.
