

SOUTH AFRICAN COUNCIL FOR EDUCATORS (SACE) ACCELERATION PLAN IS AIMED AT ASSISTING PRINCIPALS AND DEPUTY PRINCIPALS TO REPORT THEIR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES.

The Council has extended the reporting period for the first three years of the CPTD cycle for principals and deputy principals by SIX MONTHS.

The extension should be understood to be saying that, the principals and deputy principals PD point account for the first three-year cycle will be active until end of June 2017, whilst the cycle has ended in December 2016. When reporting a PD activity the date in which the PD activity was attended, will determine whether the update will fall in the new cycle that started in January 2017 or the previous cycle ended in December 2016.

After June 2017 the PD account for the previous cycle will be closed

THE THREE YEAR CYCLE OF SCHOOL BASED HEAD OF DEPARTMENTS IS COMING TO AN END AT THE END OF 2017, IT IS EXPECTED THAT THEY SHOULD HAVE ACQUIRED 150 PD POINTS, IF THEY ARE TO BE AWARDED WITH SACE CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT
